Event Timeline

The Ride will begin and end at Kitsch Wines. Prior to departure, please visit the CAN tent to check-in and pick up your ride package and Ride Passport.

Rider Depart Time: Riders will be departing in heats—your specific start time will be emailed to you on Tues, May 23rd.

Wicked Tours Wine Tour Van Depart Time: 1:00 pm from Kitsch Wines.

Return Time: All riders must complete their route and return to Kitsch Wines by 5:30pm. Food, drinks, prizes, and entertainment to follow.

Ride Passport & Prizing

Hand in your Ride Passport at the CAN tent upon returning to Kitsch Wines to be entered to win from our collection of exclusive items!

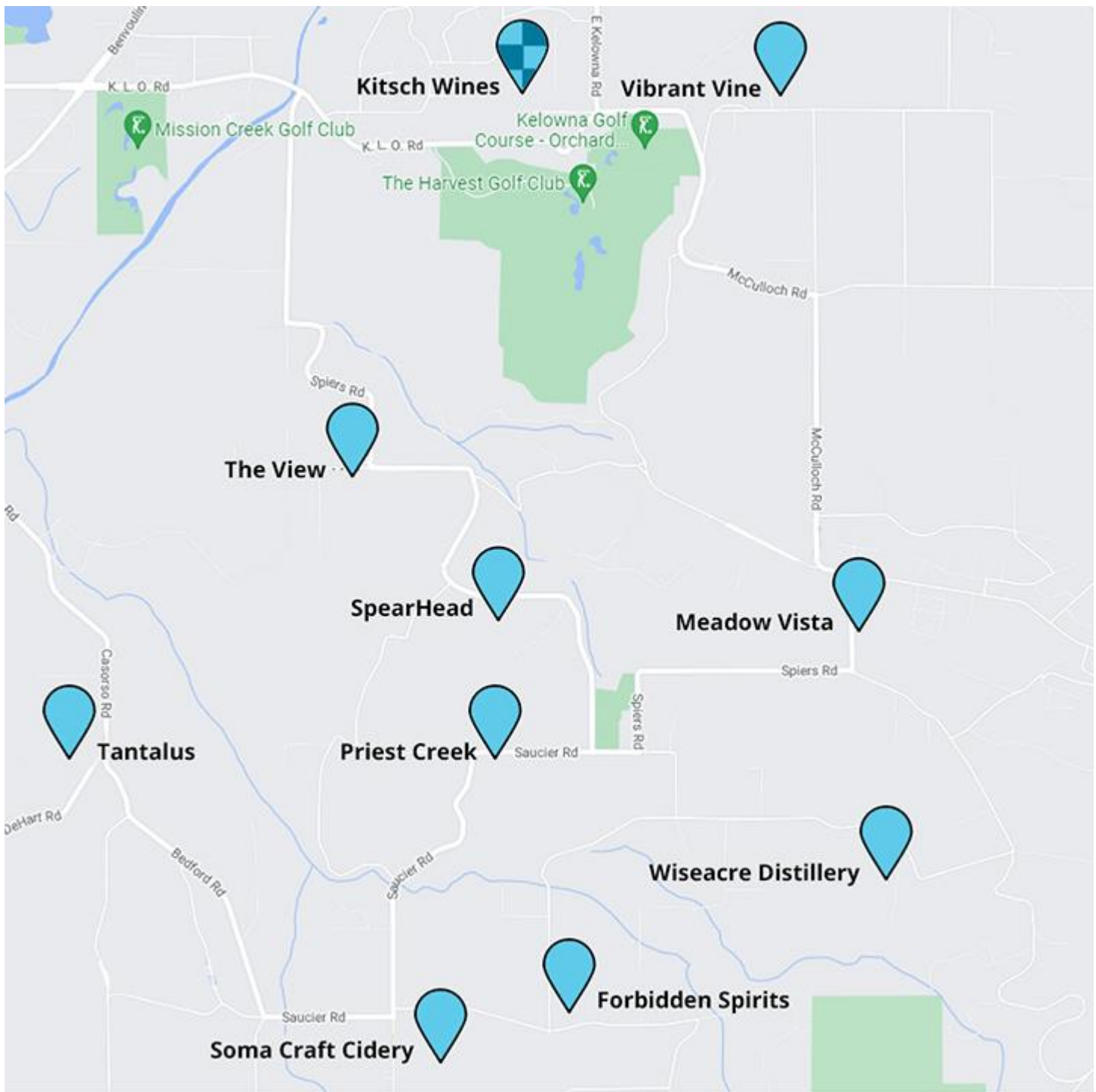
- All participants will receive a Ride Passport upon check-in. Riders will collect stickers at each location for their participation in one or all of the following:
 - a. 1 sticker per location visited
 - b. 1 sticker per challenge completed
 - c. 1 sticker if a purchase is made at a ride location*

**Volunteers will tag & transport items purchased by riders back to Kitsch Wines, so you don't have to! Riders will receive a single sticker per location regardless of amount purchased or dollar value spent.*

DAVE'S LEGACY

Inspired by his nephew MJ, Dave McAnerney started Rider Cider for Autism in 2015. The event was founded in an effort to bring more programs and services for individuals on the autism spectrum in Kelowna.

The inaugural event soon grew into what became known as the HM Commercial Ride for Autism, an annual community-building ride that showcased local wineries and cideries, while supporting Canucks Autism Network (CAN).

CAN became Dave's charity of choice due to their positive impact on MJ's life. Dave wanted to ensure that any Kelowna family with a child on the autism spectrum could benefit from the same life-changing support.

Dave's untimely passing represents a heartbreaking loss to the local business and autism community. Starting in 2023, the event has been renamed the Dave McAnerney Ride for Autism, in honour of his countless contributions.



Since launching in Kelowna just nine years ago, hundreds of local families have benefitted from CAN's growing portfolio of sports and rec programs, summer day camps, youth and adult, opportunities and year-round family experiences.

None of this would have been possible without Dave's unparalleled efforts to create positive change in his community.
