The Kelowna Ride for Autism, powered by the Stober Foundation, emphasizes fun while supporting Canucks Autism Network (CAN). Visit a few stops or visit all eight! It's your choice!

Event Timeline

The Ride will begin and end at Kitsch family home. Prior to departure, please visit the CAN tent to check-in and pick up your ride package and Ride Passport.

Rider Depart Time: Riders will be departing between 1:30pm — 1:45pm.

Return Time: All riders must complete their route and return to Kitsch no later than 5:00pm. Food, drinks, prizes, and entertainment to follow.

Ride Passport & Prizing

Hand in your Ride Passport at the CAN tent upon returning to Kitsch to be entered to win from our collection of fun items!


- All participants will receive a Ride Passport upon check-in. Riders will collect stickers at each location for their participation in one or all of the following:
 - a. 1 sticker per location visited
 - b. 1 sticker per challenge completed
 - c. 1 sticker if a purchase is made at a ride location*

*Volunteers will tag & transport items purchased by riders back to Kitsch, so you don't have to! Riders will receive a single sticker per location regardless of amount purchased or dollar value spent.

10.6 km (42 mins of riding)

13.2 km (52 mins of riding)

Kitsch > Vibrant Vine > The View > Meadow Vista > Kitsch OR Kitsch > Meadow Vista > The View > Vibrant Vine > Kitsch

Intermediate (4 to 6 stops)

14.5km (54 mins of riding)

Kitsch > Vibrant Vine > Priest Creek > Spearhead > The View > Kitsch OR Kitsch > The View > Spearhead > Priest Creek > Vibrant Vine > Kitsch

18.6 km (1hr 8 mins of riding)

Kitsch > Tantalus > Soma > Meadow Vista > Vibrant Vine > Kitsch OR
Kitsch > Vibrant Vine > Meadow Vista - Soma > Tantalus > Kitsch

20.7km (1hr 16 mins of riding)

Kitsch > Tantalus > Hidden Vines > Soma > Meadow Vista > Vibrant Vine > Kitsch OR
Kitsch > Vibrant Vine > Meadow Vista > Soma > Hidden Vines > Tantalus > Kitsch

Advanced (7 to 8 stops)

21.8km (1hr 24 mins of riding)

Kitsch > Vibrant Vine > The View > SpearHead > Priest Creek > Soma > Hidden Vines > Tantalus > Kitsch OR Kitsch > Tantalus > Hidden Vines > Soma > Priest Creek > SpearHead > The View > Vibrant Vine > Kitsch

22.7km (1hr 26 mins of riding)

Kitsch > Vibrant Vine > Soma > Tantalus > Priest Creek > Spearhead > The View > Kitsch OR Kitsch > The View > Spearhead > Priest Creek > Tantalus > Soma > Vibrant Vine > Kitsch

EPIC Tour: 24.8km (1hr 33 mins of riding)

Kitsch > Vibrant Vine > Meadow Vista > Hidden Vines > Tantalus > Soma > Priest Creek > Spearhead > The View > Kitsch OR Kitsch > The View > Spearhead > Priest Creek > Soma > Tantalus > Hidden Vines > Meadow Vista > Vibrant Vine > Kitsch
